### Flood Rescue

We have attended flood rescue situations nationwide and overseas on request by police forces and overseas agencies who recognise the skills and expertise IRC can bring to flood rescue.

### What we can offer

- A free of charge service responding 24/7
- Complete search teams equipped with specialist equipment such as underwater search cameras.
- Water search teams with inshore and coastal rescue boats
- Water search teams have recognised boat-handling and safety qualifications.
- Blue light rescue ambulances and qualified response drivers
- VHF radio and satellite communications for remote environments
