Logistics and Needs Assessments

We have attended earthquakes and other disasters for over 30 years working closely with local agencies, the United Nations, other search and rescue teams and various aid agencies.

What we can offer

- A free of charge service responding 24/7
- VHF radio and satellite communications for remote environments
- Complete search teams equipped with specialist search equipment such as thermal imaging cameras and ultrasonic listening devices
- Blue light rescue ambulances and qualified response drivers
- Water search teams with inshore and coastal rescue boats suitable for hot zone operations
