What we can offer

- A free of charge service responding 24/7
- Complete search teams equipped with specialist search equipment such as thermal imaging cameras and ultrasonic listening devices
- •Blue light rescue ambulances and qualified response drivers
- •VHF radio and satellite communications for remote environments
- Water search teams with inshore and coastal rescue boats suitable for hot zone operations
